now 887, 848 of which have current known populations.**

Re-determinations or annotations:

Agrostis hyemalis (Walter) Britton, Sterns & Poggenburg = *Agrostis striata* Willdenow

Aronia arbutifolia (Linnaeus) Elliott = *Aronia xprunifolia* (Marshall) Rehder - The original identification was based on immature fruit. The annotation was based on observing the same population later in the year.

Betula papyrifera, KBS 553 = *Betula cordifolia* Regel

Crataegus intricata Lange, KBS 340 = *Crataegus biltmoreana* Beadle - annotated Arthur Haines, 2006

Crataegus coccinea L., KBS 132 = *Crataegus biltmoreana* Beadle - annotated Arthur Haines, 2009

Eleocharis ovata (Roth) Roemer & Schultes = *Eleocharis obtusa* (Willdenow) Schultes

Platanthera huronensis (Nuttall) Lindley = *Platanthera aquilonis* Sheviak

Spergula arvensis = *Spergula morisonii* Boreau - Thanks to Alexy Zinovjev for asking me to check the *Spergula arvensis* collections at MASS for this species.

Doellingeria umbellata (Miller) Nees - KBS 913, 9/02/2009

Echinocystis lobata (Michaux) Torrey & Gray - KBS 898, 08/26/2008

Hypopithys lanuginosa (Michaux) Nuttall - 09/2011 photo, but no specimen.

Moehringia lateriflora (Linnaeus) Fenzl - KBS 907, 6/11/2009 – found by Scott Rasmussen

Phryma leptostachya Linnaeus - KBS 1105, 09/23/2011 – found by Scott Rasmussen, also known from historical collections

Platanthera psycodes (Linnaeus) Lindley - KBS 914, 09/02/2009 – also known from historical collections

Ranunculus repens Linnaeus - KBS 912, 08/07/2009

Salix atrocineria Brotero - KBS 917, 09/22/2009 - found by Alexy Zinovjev and Irina Kadis

Solidago puberula Nuttall - KBS 919, 09/24/2009

Vernonia noveboracensis (Linnaeus) Michaux - KBS 916, 09/07/2009
